INTRODUCTION

The theme for this SIG 14 activity is literacy interventions, word reading, and dynamic assessment in culturally and linguistically diverse (CLD) populations. Topics include (a) scoping reviews of culturally responsive literacy interventions in speech-language pathology, (b) a meta-analysis of dynamic assessment as it relates to word-reading skills in school-age children, and (c) conceptualization of a universal dynamic assessment screener for developmental language disorder.
